November 5, 1928 - July 18, 2020

Randolph Joseph Hall, Jr., Son of the late Nancy Armwood and Randolph Hall Sr, was born on November 5, 1928 in Baltimore, Maryland. Married to Mary Hortense Haynes in 1964 and widowed in 2001. Randy, a.k.a "Old Man" whose highest level of formal education was unknown, boast of how he entered the Air Force at age 13, tweaking his paperwork and surpassing many of his peers scoring in the top percentile of his class. Receiving a degree from Cortez Peters Business School was also a source of pride for him. After leaving the military, Randy sought work in Sparrow Point, like many other black men of that era. However, his entrepreneurial spirit took precedence, and it wasn't long before he opened the doors to his first business; "Randy's Grocery", located on Holbrook and Oliver St. His astute business acumen soon led him to develop a one of a kind bread receipt and soon after he launched his second venture called "Randy's Dandy Bread".

After the success of this venture, Randy's Midas touch continued when he acquired "Ebony Supermarket" located on Hartford Road, followed by the acquisition of another grocery store located on Washington St. It was apparent that Randy was an astute business man, who successfully launched, acquired and managed several grocery stores in Baltimore. Yet in 1995, Randy's entrepreneurial spirit once again lead him to purchase another business; this time a bar called, "The Old Man's Place" which became a source of pride for him. Randy would go on to purchase and open up several additional

businesses in Baltimore including several stores located on Monument Street and ultimately helped his daughter, Tammy, launch her own business, "Tammy's Place", also located in Baltimore. It was important for Randy to help other black owned businesses open and thrive.

A man of little words, his action spoke volumes, and impacted many, so much so that the members of the community succeeded in petitioning for Holbrook and Oliver Street to pay homage to him by displaying a street sign bearing his name. Not only will the impact of his generosity resonate with his family and those he touched, but if you drive on the Eastside of Baltimore, you will see the legacy of a man, "Randolph J Hall JR", who made an incredible difference in the lives of many that will change the world. One "Old Man" from the Eastside!

Quietly, on Tuesday, July 18, 2020 he departed. Idolized, adored, loved, and cherished by many, he was survived by his daughters Tammy, Marilyn, Annette, and our sister Gee-Gee; his sons Derek and Leon. Randy also leaves behind many of his grand children Lenard, Kenny, Kenard, Albert, Tavon, Monica, and many great and great, great grand children in addition to a host of other family and friends. He was our hero and God only knows how much we will miss him. Love you very much Old Man!
