Raquita NaShawn Jackson, lovingly known to as “Quita” or “Quita Boo” by family and friends, was called to eternal rest by our Heavenly Father on Saturday, October 26, 2024.

She was born on Tuesday evening, July 9, 1985, the oldest of three girls born to Ronald and Julie Y. Jackson, raised in a Christian home where she was taught the Word of God and the importance of living a life of integrity, strong character and excellence. Raquita was noted to be a very passionate, dedicated hard worker. She was employed by eCMMS Foxconn Technology Group in Sandston, VA where she proudly earned career certificates.

Raquita loved food, especially her granny Mary's spoonbread, her favorite dish. She cooked amazing breakfasts, which was the only meal she could cook! She was a die-hard Washington Commanders fan, loved any type of music, especially by the artist Prince and loved to dance.
