Rawlins Carrington Bray was born on Friday, February 12, 1988, in Albany, Georgia to Eric Newton and McKesia Bray.

Carrington received his formal education in Virginia Beach, Chesapeake, and Newport News, Virginia. His love for high end fashion motivated him to further his education in New York City at New York State University (FIT) where he received his bachelor's degree. He received his master's degree from Parsons Paris School of Art & Design in Paris, France.

Carrington accepted Christ as his personal savior at an early age while attending New Mount Olive Baptist Church in Hampton, Virginia where he was a member of the Youth Choir, Youth Ministry and Venture Crew.

On July 23, 2008, Carrington enlisted in the United States Army and served his country proudly with 7th Special Force Group at Eglin Air Force Base as a Military Intelligence Signal Voice Interceptor (Linguist). He completed two Combat tours of duty to Afghanistan and assignments to Germany and Colombia to name a few. He completed his time-of-service July 22, 2014.

Carrington was a lifelong student who taught himself several languages. He was fluent in writing and speaking Spanish, French, and Italian. Carrington loved music! In his leisure time, he taught himself to play the guitar and

keyboard. He enjoyed learning and traveling abroad. He completed an internship in 2017 with an Italian shoemaker and obtained a Master of Art in Paris, France in 2019.

Carrington was simply AMAZING! He had a kind spirit and an easy-going nature. He was highly intelligent, thoughtful, warm-hearted, lovable, courageous, interesting, fun, helpful and respectful.
