Raymond Ellsworth Hull departed from life on February 5, 2016 in Baltimore, Maryland. Raymond was born July 27, 1945 in Goldvein, Virginia, to Lonnie and Eileen Turner. being a regular kid from Baltimore, Maryland, Raymond was thrust into manhood early. In the arc of his life, Daddy earned his place in history as decorated African American fulfilling "the greatest example of patriotism in the history of this nation by giving up his life for a liberty that was denied to him." He served as a specialist four in The National Army's 82nd Airborne Division of the United States Military.

He married his first wife Ethail Smith on August 24, 1964 in Baltimore, Maryland, and had four children; Germaine Eileen Lewis, Raymond Anthony "Tony" Hull, Ranjit Rhamon Hull and Karen Anita Morrison. He married his second wife Hattie Lorraine Page in Baltimore, Maryland, and from that marriage, he had four children; Makeba Yolanda Harris, Swanzeta Rocheta Nciweni, Yusief Hassan Latif Hull, and Marian Naya Hull He also has two daughters; Yvette Hull and Adriennie Hull. He is preceded in death by his children and survived by: one sister, a cousin Dorothy White, his fiancée Veronica Williams and many nieces and nephews, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

What we do know about Daddy is that he served his country proudly. He had a charm with people from all over the world. Some will certainly say he served

his time on this earth. As his children, we wish we had the privilege to get that Daddy's little kings and queens experience but the stars had it different. And although it wasn't easy and still isn't, and we cannot change the unremembered moments, we are stronger for it. 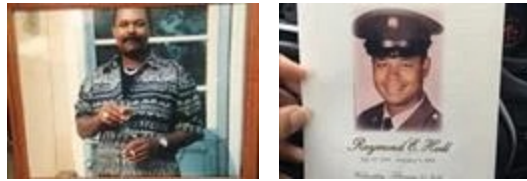
