“ *I didn't get to know Raymond for long, but he struck up a conversation with me a couple nights before his surgery at the VA hospital where my father was in the same room with him. He wanted me to meet his daughter, Ruth, so badly and I missed her the first night, but met her the next day and now I understand why he wanted me to meet her. He told me he wanted to survive his surgery mostly because he had daughters and that he was trying to find a way to ask forgiveness for transgressions of the past and make it up to them, but he couldn't find the right words to say it. I told him "Probably the words you just said to me would be just fine." I will never forget how he said, "When it comes down to it, those girls are my life, and that's all I really have is my family." Wise words. I had asked him if I could bring him anything when I returned the next day and later he slipped me a note and he had written on it "Egg Salad on Wheat" and I left and called my husband and told him to put some eggs on to boil so they would be there when I got home...I had some egg salad to make. I will never forget you, Raymond. You taught me about a father's love for his daughters...imperfect, but true.*
