REGINALD LEWIS MACER, JR., the son of Sylvia Parmlee and the late Reginald Lewis Macer, Sr., was born October 20, 1969 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on Thursday, November 24, 2016.

Reggie had a strong faith and was very active in his church, St. William of York. There he served as an altar boy and participated in religious classes five days a week. At the tender age of nine he was diagnosed with cancer. Reggie was a strong soldier and fought through his illness by relying on his faith and his deep trust in his God.

During his early years, he attended parochial school. He later attended Walbrook High School where he enjoyed being a member of JROTC Program. He later attended TEST College where he obtained his certification as a HVAC Technician.

During his years of employment, he worked for the Department of Public Works. Later he continued his employment as a licensed exterminator with Ehrlich Pest Control Company. Reggie later began employment with the Sheraton Hotel as a Staff Engineer.

He was affectionately known by many as "Reggie", "Reg", or "Peabody". He was known to crack a joke and make you laugh until you cried. He was the

perfect son, brother, father, fiancée and friend. To know him was to love him. You couldn't find a father that was as committed and dedicated to his children as Reggie. He enjoyed hanging out with his older buddies; cracking jokes, playing cards and "tasting." He and his fiancée to wine festivals, went dancing, on vacations and enjoyed time with family and friends.

In 2014, Reggie joined the most worshipful Harim Grand Lodge located at 1205 Eutaw Place where he received his Entered Apprentice Degree in Masonry. Reggie was a member of Mount Zion Lodge #10.
