REGINALD ALBERT ROBINS (REGGIE) was born on March 25, 1966 in Baltimore, MD to Ms. Loretta Robins and Mr. Ray Adams.

Reggie received his education in Baltimore City Schools and was a proud, spirited and boastful member of the Paul Laurence Dunbar Class of 1984 (Go Poets). An interest in the culinary arts and food service led him to receive formal training at the Baltimore Culinary School of Arts.

Hospitality is defined as the friendly and generous reception and entertainment of guest, visitors or strangers. We can add Reggie's name to this definition. Matthew 25 says "Then the King will say to those on his right, Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. Taking the drive to care for others to the limit, Reggie was a Sales Management Consultant with PFP/The Family Security Plan for 18 years. He wanted to make sure that his clients were “covered and cared for”. He looked forward to the vacation trips with friends and colleagues. The consummate host even in leisure, there were so many instances, remembrances and pictures of Reggie serving and seeing to the needs of others.

Last Friday, God moved. He saw that Reggie’s service on earth was complete. God let him know that there was nothing more for him to do. His life was now an example.

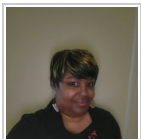
