REGINALD CHARLES WARREN, son of the late Seaba Warren and Eva Fisher Warren, was born on November 25, 1935 in Kinston, North Carolina. He was the oldest child, preceding the late Carol Jean Warren, and transitioned on June 16, 2021 at Frederick Villa in Baltimore, Maryland.

Reginald “Reggie” was educated in the Kinston, North Carolina and the Baltimore City Public School System. He was a proud graduate of the Paul Laurence Dunbar High School and maintained friendships with Cornelia DuBois (Smith), Rosetta Hill (Jackson) and Sydney “Zeke” Fields. Upon graduation he attended Morgan State College. At Morgan, he met and married the late Gloria V. Warren on April 5, 1958. They enjoyed traveling across the United States while collecting sports memorabilia from various stadiums and arenas in each state which was meticulously tucked away in a special place.
