Renee` Cecelia Parm, the only child born to the late Willie Mae Philips Woolfolk and the late Edward Parm on April 6, 1949 in Washington, DC, transitioned from labor to rest on Friday, March 18, 2011 at Virginia Commonwealth University Health Systems in Richmond, VA.

Renee` was educated in the Richmond Public School system and graduated from Armstrong High School in 1967. She also graduated from the Medical College of Virginia School of Radiology where she worked as a registered x-ray technologist and diagnostic medical sonographer in OB/GYN. She was a member of the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers.

She accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Gethsemane Baptist Church, South Hill, VA. She later became a member of Fourth Baptist Church, Richmond, VA.

She dedicated her entire career to the field of OB/GYN ultrasound at the VCU Health Systems, formerly known as the Medical College of VA. She served as a support system and resource to all of her patients. She was an expert in her field and was well known in the Richmond medical community for her knowledge and skills. She developed and flourished under the guidance of Dr. Robert Petres, Dr. John Seeds, Dr. William Fitzhugh and others. She devoted over 35 years of her life to her career and retired as a supervisor of her

department. She taught technicians, interns, residents, and doctors. All under her tutelage were held to a high standard of excellence.

Renee` was known for her love for the people, the culture, and the art of the continent of Africa. She also enjoyed traveling, especially to Africa and the Caribbean. All who knew Renee` knew her co-workers were like extended family that she truly loved.
