Revanette Simone Gilmore, departed this earthly life on May 28, 2026 in Baltimore, MD, at the age of 63.

Revanette continued her education at Virginia State University, where she majored in Special Education and earned numerous accolades. Her years at VSU helped shape the educator, mentor and advocate she would become and she remained a proud supporter of her alma mater throughout her life. A lifelong scholar, she earned a Masters of Education degree from Coppin State University in June 1995 and later continued her studies at Loyola University in administration and supervision certification coursework.

Revanette devoted nearly 30 years to the field of special education, serving in

roles that included Special Education Teacher, Diagnostic/Prescriptive Teacher, Assistant Principal and Director of Education. Her leadership career included work at Villa Maria School and The Children's Guild, where she guided school operations with care, compassion and precision.

She later served as an educational consultant with WEG, where she found deep fulfillment helping families navigate the special education process. For sixteen years, she also served as a University Supervisor for Johns Hopkins University, mentoring and supporting aspiring educators in the classroom. Throughout her career, she advocated fiercely for children and families, ensuring they received the support, dignity and opportunities they deserved.

Revanette loved fiercely and supported wholeheartedly, freely sharing her wisdom while encouraging the dreams and goals of others. Her warmth made people feel welcome, her honesty kept them grounded and her strength reminded them they could always count on her. She brought laughter and light into every room she entered. Her love extended to her beloved dogs, Money, Rock, Jordan and Gucci, whose companionship brought her great joy. She believed deeply in helping others and lived a life defined by a service, compassion and an unwavering commitment to making life better for those around her.
