Ronnie received her education from the Baltimore City Public School System, a 1976 graduate of Lake Clifton High School. After graduating high school, she attended Coppin University for one year, and later attended Baltimore City Community College where she became Certified Nursing Assistant. Ronnie spent her life as a dedicated Healthcare Worker for 40 years until her retirement, after which, she decided to become a fulltime grandmother.

During the course of her time in high school, she met her high school sweetheart and the love of her life, Jerome Harrison, known as "Romey." they began dating and were united in Holy Matrimony on February 4, 1978. they became "one" and their marriage lasted for 48 years until the day the Lord called her home.
