RHONDA JO WHITTED WELCH, the beloved and eldest child of Barbara Howard Whitted and the late Carl Whitted, was born on November 15, 1955 in Baltimore, Maryland and died suddenly on June 23, 2009 at Northwest Hospital. Rhonda received her education in the Baltimore County public schools and graduated from Lansdowne Senior High School. She then went on to further her education at Catonsville Community College and the University of Maryland at Baltimore County where she received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Nursing. On July 5, 1980, Rhonda and Jeffrey Allen Welch were married in Elkridge, Maryland. From that union was born Jessica Megan Welch. Rhonda worked as a registered nurse in the Intensive Care Units of Lutheran Hospital Liberty Medical Center. She loved helping and caring for others and always greeted her patients with a smile. Rhonda continued working until she became severely disabled with rheumatoid arthritis. Although she was wheelchair bound, she never let her disability get in the way of her cheerful and loving personality. Children adored her. They were drawn to her presence and loved being around her. Her dedication to Jessica was unmistakable and readily apparent to anyone who saw them together. Rhonda returned to school after her nursing career ended and obtained a certification in accounting from the Community College of Baltimore City. She occasionally provided bookkeeping services to small business owners in her home. Not one to sit idle, Rhonda became proficient in internet research and webpage design. These skills were self-taught. She leaves to cherish her memory; her

mother, Barbara Whitted; Jeffrey Welch; her daughter, Jessica; her sister, Monica Whitted Baisey; three brothers and sisters-in-law, Eric and Patricia Whitted, Stephen and Tracey Whitted and Bret and Jennifer Whitted; two nieces, Trinity Whitted and Tramaine Gause; five nephews, Bradley Whitted, Dominic Whitted, Deion Kasian, Shawn Miller and Raymond Whitted; and a host of friends.
