January 29, 1950 - October 3, 2021

RICHARD DOUGLAS PERRY, 71, was born on January 29, 1950, to the late great Andrew Perry Sr. and Berta Bell Wiggins Perry of Newport News, VA. Richard departed his life on Sunday, Oct. 3, 2021 at 1:45 am after a lengthy illness under hospice care at Post-Acute Nursing and Rehab in Baltimore, MD.

The Perry family relocated to Baltimore (Turner Station), Maryland in 1954. Richard received his education in the Baltimore County school system and graduated from Sollers Point Sr. High School in 1968. He was converted and baptized at a young age and attended Mt. Olive Baptist Church located in Turner Station. In 1971, Richard enlisted in the United States Army and was stationed in West Point, NY.
