Richard Monty Roberts, son of Dorothy Jean Madison and the late William Roberts was born on July 22, 1954 in Baltimore, MD. He departed this life on September 2, 2020 after a lengthy illness.

“Richie” as he was affectionately known by family and friends, joined the United States Army where he served until he was honorably discharged in July, 1973.

Richard received his education from the Baltimore City Public School System and earned his diploma in August of 1982.

Richard was employed by the Maryland Slag Company for a number of years. He was a dedicated volunteer at the ValleyBridge Recovery House for over 10 years. Later, he was employed by Gable Signs and Graphics until his health began to fail.
