Robbin earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education from Virginia State University and was a second grade teacher at Jacob L. Adams Elementary School in Richmond,Va.Prior to her teaching profession,Robbin was in the field of nursing,with aspirations of becoming a RN. During that time,she took time off to spend with her children and enjoyed volunteering in her son Devon's classroom. One day while volunteering,Devon's teacher told her that her "gift" was working with children,and asked her to consider teaching as a profession..and thus,her teaching career began.Shortly after,she began working as an instructional tutor at Adams Elementary while simultaneously pursuing her degree in Elementary Education.
