Robena Richardson departed this life at age 90 on March 25, 2009. She was born Robena Williams on July 31, 1918 just before the end of World War I in Baltimore, Maryland. She was so excited to see the first Black American elected for President of the United States in her lifetime. She was independent and lived alone. She loved going anywhere with her family even if it was just for the ride. Her hobbies included watching soap operas, knitting, word-puzzles and expeditions to Dover Downs. She loved listening to music especially Marvin Gaye. She wrote journals. Her special treats were Hershey's kisses and Manischewitz. She was loved by many and will be missed by many more..
