Bobby was able to buy the sneakers with the help of his mom and scored 30 points in the game. In 2011, Bobby was awarded for being the leading scorer in the history of the Community Sports Club League that was in existence from 1976 to 1981. Bobby often led his team to championship games locally and out of

state. He later became a basketball coach and led his kids to numerous championship games as well.

Bobby made friends everywhere he went. He was a very friendly and likeable person. He loved to laugh, make other laugh and have a good time. Bobby gave of himself to both adults and children. He was always willing to listen, give advice, help in any way he could and was just very supportive. He especially enjoyed traveling and loved spending time with his family. And boy, did he love to dress and take pictures. And he was not afraid to wear pink or yellow. Bobby accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior.
