Robert Clifford Hill, affectionately known as “Junie” and “Bob”, was born on September 4, 1929, in Baltimore, Maryland, to the late John and Eugie Hill. Steward Hill peacefully went home to be with the Lord on Monday, July 23, 2007, after a lengthy illness. Robert graduated from Carver Vocational Technical High School, where he learned the trade that he enjoyed—painting and wallpapering. Until his illness, Robert managed the Bob Hill Painting and Decorating Company, where he personally performed numerous paint jobs, with the assistance of his son. He served in the United States Army, where he earned the rank of corporal, and was honorably discharged. He was a veteran of the Korean War. After his departure from the service, he was employed by the Allied Chemical Company (now Honeywell) as a chemical operator. He retired from Allied after more than 35 years of service. At an early age, Robert was baptized at John Wesley Methodist Church, when it was located in South Baltimore. During his teen years, he was involved in the Young Peoples Choir and the Methodist Youth Fellowship Ministries. With the relocation of the John Wesley United Methodist Church to its present edifice, The Male Chorus, The Church Council, The United Methodist Men Male Chorus, and The Finance Committee. He also served as an ordained Steward at the time of his passing. Robert was married to the late Maizie Johns on June 27, 1954. From this union three children were born; two daughters, Cherlyn and Robyn, and one son, Darryl. His favorite pastimes were reading his Bible and talking about living by the word of God. He loved to travel and drive his Honda Gold Wing

and Corvette Stingray. He enjoyed living a good and stress free life. Roberta was a devoted father and grandfather who truly loved his family. He will be lovingly remembered and truly missed by all who knew him. He will always be remembered for his caring, sharing, strength, and commitment.
