Robert Edward Jones, Jr. was born in Richmond, VA on March 22, 1949 to Robert and Catherine Jones. Bob was baptized at an early age and attended First African Baptist Church. He was educated in the Richmond Public School System and graduated from Maggie L. Walker in 1967. In 1972, he married Daisy B. Bullock. Bob, as he was affectionately known worked briefly as a Richmond Police Officer followed by several years in the trucking industry. In 2006, he retired from Federal Express after 23 years of service. Bob showed his love for children by giving to many charitable organizations over the years. He supported at least three children in Africa, to adulthood in the Adopt-a-Child program through the Word Vision program. Many other children in the area have been helped by his generosity and attention. Bob, an avid Dallas Cowboys fan, loved to sing. Over the years, he used his rich baritone voice to praise God in several choirs. While singing with the Male Celebration Chorus, he performed at the White House and appeared on NBC's Today Show several times. Reading the Bible all the way through once or twice a year earned Bob the nickname "Bible Scholar" by some. Many times he would argue with others if he thought they had interpreted a passage incorrectly. Bob passed away peacefully at home on June 10, 2008, after a two year battle with lung cancer. His father, Robert E. Jones, Sr. and his brother Ronald T. Jones preceded him in death. He is survived by his loving wife of 36 years, Daisy B. Jones; son, Roderick D. Jones (Tonda); daughter, Traysi Beckwith (Rhamel); mother, Catherine Jones; father-in-law, Warren
