Robert Kenneth Gosnell, affectionately known as "Bob" to his family and friends, was born on January 21, 1921 in Sykesville, MD to Armfield and Lillie Gosnell. Robert departed this life on June 27, 2015. He was one of eight children and was preceded in death by his parents and siblings. Robert was educated in the public schools, elementary education in Johnsville, MD and high school in Westminster, MD. He was a graduate of Hampton University. He also did graduate work at the University of Maryland. Robert was joined in marriage with Ethlyn Gosnell on November 16, 1951. He volunteered to serve in the United States Air Force during World War II. He was a teacher in Hagerstown, MD, Charles County, MD and at Carver Vocational High School in Baltimore, MD. Bob was an active sportsman. He belonged to the Hunt Club of South Boston, Virginia, the Washington Yacht Club and a member of the gentlemen's group of the Sphinx Club. He was also a Mason.
