



## Robert Ellis Hampton

May 16, 1945 - June 12, 2012

Robert Ellis Hampton, Hamp or Hambone, as he was affectionately called, son of the late James Dover and Edna Hampton Stokes, was born on May 16, 1945 in Greensboro, North Carolina. He departed this life on June 12, 2012 after a brief illness. Robert was the second of seven children, in which one brother, Earl Stokes and two sons, Dwayne Hampton and Robert Ledwell (Mickey) preceded him in death.

Hamp attended Dudley Senior High School in Greensboro, North Carolina, where he was an avid and outstanding basketball player. He was also well-known for his singing abilities. As a young man his love of music lead him to professional recordings with his group, The Objectives, where they were recognized as up and coming new recording stars. Hamp had a relationship with Patricia Ledwell that was blessed with two sons, Kenny and Robert Ledwell.

Hamp moved to Baltimore, Maryland in 1967, where he met and married Paulette Barksdale and through this union twin sons were born, Corey and Courtney Hampton. He then later met and married his soulmate, Mari-Am Joyce Hampton. He received Christ early on and was an active and faithful member of Mt. Lebanon Baptist Church, where he served the Lord working on the Usher Board and singing on the Male Chorus.

He enjoyed performing with his spiritual brothers and group members, The Bible Boyz throughout the tri-state area. He worked for various companies, including Domino Sugar and Alban Tractor, from which he retired. He was currently employed with Baltimore City Department of Recreation, at the Mt. Pleasant Ice Arena, where he was a dedicated employee.
