Robert Lee Workman was born December 11, 1922 in Fountain Inn, South Carolina to the late Johnnie and Della Workman. He departed this life on October 31, 2002 after a brief illness. Robert was an only child and was raised in South Carolina where he received his education in the public school system and attended the Byron High School. He received Jesus Christ as his personal Savior at an early age and was baptized at Pilgrim Baptist Church in Fountain Inn, Carolina. Robert served three years in the United States Army and received an honorable discharge. In 1946 Robert was united in Holy Matrimony to Connie Karen Garrett, who preceded him in death in 1997, and from this union three sons were born, Arthur Sr., John and Bobby. He was affectionately and lovingly called "POP". Robert moved his family in 1951 to Baltimore, Maryland and joined the Mount Hebron Baptist Church where he was a faithful member. In 1959 he and his wife, along with others, helped to organize the church that is now called Southern Friendship Baptist Church, therefore making them charter members. He was a very faithful member and worked diligently in the church. He was a member of the Trustee Ministry and the Vocal Choir. He was an honorary member of the Senior Ushers Ministry and also used to sing with the Male Chorus. He was employed for the Comfort Spring and Mattress Company. Later in 1960 he was employed as a truck driver with Associated Trucking Company and was a member of the teamsters union. He worked hard to provide for his family and retired in 1986. Robert leaves to cherish his memory; four sons, Elane, and Arthur Sr., of South

Carolina, John, and Bobby of Maryland; one daughter, Robin Evans of South Carolina; one daughter-in-law, Penny; two grandsons; three granddaughters, nine great grandchildren, three sisters-in-law, one brother-in-law; one adopted sister, Elizabeth Boulware; one godson, Michael A. Tillman; and a host of other relatives and friends.
