ROBERT LAFAYETTE MILLER was born June 18, 1943 to Charles Andrew Miller and Emil Allison Miller in Clover, South Carolina. He was the younger of two sons. He went home to be with the Lord on October 9, 2017.

He was awarded a Doctor of humane Letters by the Eastern Theological Seminary in Lynchburg, Virginia. He became known for his steady leadership and consistent Christian concern.
