



## Robert Lee Mitchell

June 19, 1939 - May 9, 2022

REV. ROBERT LEE MITCHELL was born in Sanford, Florida on June 19, 1939 to the late Minnie Lee Terry and John O'Neil. He transitioned to be with the Lord on Monday, May 9, 2022.

He graduated from high school in Sanford, Florida and North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University in Greensboro, NC with a Bachelor of Art degree in Art. Robert began his career in Education as an art teacher with Loudoun County Public Schools in Virginia. He later worked as an art teacher with the District of Columbia Public Schools. He eventually began employment with the DC Department of Corrections in Washington as a teacher and correction specialist where he later retired from public service. While employed at the department, Robert taught GED courses to inmates along with offering counsel. Both his colleagues and students stated that he was a "Christian with moral integrity with respect for life". He was also well respected at his final place of employment with the Newseum in Washington, D.C., which is a museum dedicated to the history of journalism. He was a tour guide for visitors whose smile was infectious and whose warmth was felt by those he encountered. As one who was well versed on American history, he was willing and able to answer any questions that patrons had. Upon his retirement, you could often find Robert and his family visiting lakes throughout

Maryland, fishing to relax and find solace.

Robert was taught core Christian values by his mother who influenced him to serve God and become active in ministry. He was an ordained deacon at Walker Memorial Baptist Church in Washington, D.C. After receiving further ministerial preparation he became an ordained minister in 2010. He also received a Master of Divinity in Christian Leadership in 2011 from Faith Christian University and School. Rev. Robert became an active member of the Prison Ministry at Jericho City of Praise Ministries and ministered to inmates at the department of corrections in Lorton, Virginia. Rev. Robert was a preacher, teacher, evangelist and man of God who gave hope to many. He was a student of the Bible, as you could often find him among his personal collection of texts reading and studying the promises of God found in His Word.

Rev. Robert Lee Mitchell was preceded in death by his brother, Amos Mitchell. He leaves to mourn: his wife, Joyce Smith-Mitchell; his two children, Christina Mitchell-Jolayemi (Femi) and Renee Mitchell; step-daughter, Rev. Tiffani S. Cutler (Rev. Dr. Otis Cutler, deceased); two grandchildren, Monet Proctor and Marshe Proctor; step-granddaughter, Milan Cutler; sister-in-law, Min. Angela Flager (Claude); and a host of nieces, nephews and friends
