



## Robert Lee Powell Sr.

January 30, 1942 - April 23, 2013

ROBERT LEE POWELL, SR., son of the late Warren Hasten Powell and Dorothy Louise Gregg-Powell, was born on January 30, 1942 in Baltimore, Maryland. Affectionately known as "Bobby," he departed this life at 6:39 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at Greater Baltimore Medical Center (GBMC), surrounded by loved ones. Bobby was educated in the Baltimore County Public School System. On July 1, 1961, he married Joan Lucille LeVere and from this union four children were born: Vicki Lynn, Robin Leah, Robert Lee, Jr. and Juan LeVere. He honorably served his country in the United States Army. His federal service continued as a United States Postal worker until he retired in September of 1992. After retirement, he was employed for many years by Mrs. Mary Wanamaker Watriss until his passing. At an early age, Bobby accepted Christ as his personal Savior and joined Gough United Methodist Church where he faithfully served. He was a trustee, treasurer, chairman of the cemetery committee, prayer advocate for the Baltimore North Cluster Churches and was President of the United Methodist Men. He had a melodious baritone voice that he used to sing with the Gough Choir, Interdenominational Gospel Choir and the Post Office Glee Club. Bobby never forgot a birthday and always called to sing for the recipient. He had many friends and was loved by everyone. He leaves to cherish his loving memory: his devoted and loving wife of fifty-one years, Joan Lucille LeVere Powell; four loving children, Vicki L. Powell- Biggers, Robin L. Powell, Robert L. Powell, Jr., and Juan L. Powell, Sr.; a devoted daughter-in-law, Cerita L. Powell; fourteen
