ROBERT McKENDRY SUTTON, son of the late Ransom Sutton and Ella Rogers, was born on October 6, 1919 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on August 22, 2013.

Robert was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System where he graduated high school at the age of fifteen. He served as a Private First Class in the United States Army. After being honorably discharged from the military, he took advantage of the G.I. Bill and enrolled in the Peabody Conservatory where he learned to read music and play the piano and drums. Robert had many jobs, but made a career as a supervisor for the United States Postal Service where he retired.
