Robinette Corrine Robinson was born in Richmond, Virginia on December 28, 1909 to the late William D. Robinson and Josephine H. Robinson. She was preceded in death by a sister, Betty B. Robinson and a brother, Alpheus J. Robinson and a devoted niece Evelyn C. Winston. Ms. Robinson was a 1929 graduate of Armstrong High School, Richmond, Virginia and the Apex Beauty School in 1953.
