He was very laid back but also very kind with a lot of love to give. He was devoted to his family and provided advice and counsel to his siblings, a host of cousins, their friends, any young person who came to him for advice, and his friends, and had leftover love for the pets too. Roderick had a heart of gold and wanted nothing but the best for all that he encountered.
