



## Rodney Alan Hunter

March 22, 1965 - February 5, 2018

Rodney Alan Hunter departed this life on February 5, 2018 and is now resting peacefully in eternity with The Father. The first-born of three children to Elder Walden T. and Barbara J. Hunter; Rodney was born in Rocky Mount, NC on March 22, 1965.

Rodney received his early education in the Richmond Public Schools where he attended and graduated in 1983 from Marshall-Walker High School.

Having received the Lord in his heart, at an early age, Rodney was baptized at Greenwood Baptist Church in Hanover, VA. As his passion for the Lord grew, he became a member of Manna Christian Fellowship Church (MCF), further adopting an attitude of Jesus Christ. Just as talents were given to the servants of the Bible, Rodney was blessed with multiple abilities. Humbly recognizing the Lordship of Christ, Rodney served as a Boy Scouts troop leader and would later join like spirited men in a Street Evangelism Ministry, bringing glory to God.

Rodney would continue his growth in Christ, becoming a member of Refuge Temple Assembly of Yahweh, where he shared the gospel as a member of the choir. Upon completion of his degree, he

served as a minister, also teaching and preaching at Sussex County Prison as part of the Prison Ministry.

John 8:31-32 says "If you abide in My word, you are my disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Rodney, being humble and agreeing to the will of the Father in his life, was a free man making an eternal impact on the Kingdom of God.
