His legacy of love, dedication, and family will never be forgotten.

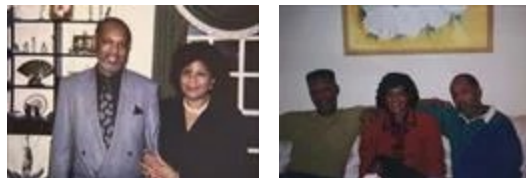
