Ronald attended the Baltimore Public School System and later graduated from Mergenthaler Vocational Tech (1971) majoring in electronics. Ronald joined the U.S. Air Force in 1971 and was Honorably Discharged in 1975. He spent four Honorable years in the United States Air Force from 1971 to 1975.
