RONALD EDWARD HUDSON was born to James and Estelle Hudson of Baltimore, Maryland on October 1, 1951. He was the youngest of four siblings and in his early years attended church at Walbrook Trinity Presbyterian with the family. Affectionately known to his family and friends as Ronnie, he attended Forest Park High School and went on to begin his studies at Morgan State University in Baltimore.
