



## Ronnie Melvin Bradsher

October 24, 1938 - August 12, 2023

MR. RONNIE MELVIN BRADSHER, age 84, departed this life and entered eternal rest Saturday, August 12, 2023, at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. He was born in Person County, Roxboro, NC on October 24, 1938, to the late Theodore Roosevelt Bradsher, Sr. and Matilda Graves Bradsher. He graduated from Person County High School, Class of 1953 and was a member of Shady Hill Missionary Baptist Church in Roxboro, NC.

Ronnie attended Carver Technical School to become a barber. He also was a chef at Haussner's Restaurant, a famous landmark for crabcakes in Baltimore, MD. He especially loved cooking breakfast for his family on Sunday morning.

He loved all sports; he was pitcher for the Dells, a slow-pitch softball team for the Baltimore City Department of Parks and Recreation. Ronnie enjoyed watching football on the weekend with family. He was a history buff and an expert on World War II. Ronnie retired from General Motors after 33 years of service.

Ronnie was a Mason with Tuscan Lodge #90. He loved attending Christian Love Baptist Church when he was able. One of his favorite entertainments was bingo with senior citizens.

He was preceded in death by his father Theodore Roosevelt Bradsher Sr., his mother Matilda Graves Bradsher, his wife Rose Curenton Bradsher with whom he shared 47 years of togetherness, and two brothers Garland V. Bradsher and Roosevelt Bradsher, Jr.
