He was affectionately referred to as having “velvet toned” voice and performed at parties with two good friends Reginald Brinkley and Marvin King billed as The Incredible Crown Affair. He enjoyed family gatherings, in the living room at his parents home playing lead guitar with his father, who also played the guitar,

singing with his siblings, story tellings (Tall Tales) of life stories and events. This still remains a family tradition until this day but absent of guitar playing . He worked for SSA and worked part time with his father in the Shipyard of the Ports of Baltimore. He was always willing to do anything to help anyone for he was a hard worker.

He spent the last 25 yrs or so due to physical health and challenges in Nursing Facilities. He recognized the needs of others and generously offered his assistance to everyone even while he was a co- resident in the nursing facilities.

He was cared for by his “Big” little sister Doretha for those 25 years and by his big brother Joseph Jr. the last 3 months of his life where he wanted to be since his oldest brother death.

He looked forward to opportunities to attend Church and He experienced the Hope of Jesus’ Return. On Thursday October 31, 2019, Ronnie laid back on the bed to rest his eternal rest until Jesus Returns on that Great Day.
