Roosevelt Powell, Jr. answered the Master's call and entered into eternal rest on Wednesday, February 3, 2021. Born to be late Roosevelt, Sr. and Sadie Powell, he was raised in Richmond, Virginia and educated in the Richmond Public School system. At an early age he accepted Christ as his personal Savior.

As a faithful servant, Roosevelt accepted the calling of Deacon at Greater Mt. Moriah Baptist Church under the pastorate of Rev. Kenneth Dennis. Roosevelt (Boo-Jack) Powell will be remembered for three things, his painting skills, his singing voice, and his sense of humor. Near the end of his singing career his brother and two of his best friends formed a gospel quartet called "The Anointed Disciples". The group was afforded many opportunities to sing all over and to open for gospel such as The Mighty Clouds of Joy, The Clinton Spirituals and Maggie Ingram and the Ingramettes.

His parents, his brother Irvin Powell and his Great Grandson, Jayquan Powell, preceded him in death.
