Rosa attended both Booker T. Washington and Frederick Douglass High Schools in Baltimore. She was employed shortly thereafter at Glen L. Martin Company as an aircraft assembler from 1951 to 1962. She then worked for the Westinghouse Corporation as an electronic technician until she retired in 1992.

She was an avid jazz enthusiast, and a member of the Baltimore Chamber Jazz Society. She fed her passion for this music by enjoying a multitude of concerts, jazz-themed cruises and hours of listening to her extensive collection of records, CD's and tapes of live shows.

Rosa enjoyed the company of her intimate family, which included two sisters, the late Rebekah Sampat and the late Inell Collins. She also had two nieces, as well as a number of great-nieces and great-nephews.

She was truly a renaissance woman, reading countless books on every topic or issue imaginable. Her creative side was evident in her writings and correspondence with her family and friends.
