Rosa Lee Wilson daughter of the late Cornelia and Plez Saunders was born August 15, 1921, in Spur, Texas. She departed this life on February 23, 2004 after a lengthy illness. She was educated in the public schools of Spur, Texas and upon the death of her mother, continued her education in St. Louis, Missouri. At the approximate age of 18, Rosa Lee moved to Wichita Falls, Texas to live with her sister, Irene. It was there that she met and married Robert Levi Baker on November 2, 1942. After marriage, she and Robert Levi moved to Pueblo, Colorado. From that union three children were born- identical twins Robert and Richard and another son Glen. In 1963, Rosa Lee and her three sons moved to Baltimore, Maryland following her divorce from Robert Levi and subsequent marriage to Irvin Wilson. She joined her husband's family church, Hopkins United Methodist, in Highland, Maryland. Prior to her illness and move to Lorien Nursing Home in November 1997, she and her son, the late Glen Baker, were active members of the church. While living in Baltimore, Rosa Lee earned her license as a Master barber. She worked several years as a Master barber in the Liberty Heights area of Baltimore. At 6:40 a.m. on Monday, February 23, 2004, Rosa Lee answered God's call to come home and leave her earthly body. She realized that death is not a tragedy for those who have faith. For them there is a finer and much better place where peace, love and joy abide. Her parents; her siblings, Irene, Louise and Virgil; and her youngest son, Glen Baker, precede her in death. She leaves behind to cherish her memory: twin sons, Richard and

Robert; two daughters-in-law, Correan and Genear; four grandchildren, Carissa, Tern, Tiffanie and Ryan; and many friends and relatives.
