She was also on the Mother's Board. She continued to serve the Lord here on earth until Thursday, December 1, 2005 when He called her home to rest in His loving arms. Rosa Mae loved the Lord with her whole heart and now she is able to be in His presence eternally. Wherever she went, she touched the hearts of many with her humble and loving spirit.
