On June 4, 1977 Rose married the love of her life, Dr. Randy Adams. They made their home in Richmond for over 41 years. To this blessed union were two daughters, Taryn Blount and Taasha Adams.

Rose was a product of Richmond Public Schools, having graduated from Maggie L. Walker High School. She later received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Education, and her Master’s Degree in Guidance from Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU).

Rose’s career started at Nabisco, Inc. Her entrepreneurial spirit led her to open Tutti Frutti, a yogurt and sandwich shop in the 6th Street Marketplace. Later she would open a second location at Innsbrook.

After working several years as an entrepreneur, she chose to pursue a passion for education in her hopes of making a difference in the lives of Richmond's youth.

Rose began her teaching career at Adult Career Development Center (ACDC). Later she accepted a position as a Guidance Counselor at G.H. Reid and Ginter Park Elementary Schools.

Rose volunteered her time and talents in many civic organizations within the community to include the Richmond Metropolitan Business League, and the Women for Wellness. Among her many hobbies were attending sporting events, fishing on The White Rose, traveling and an abundance of shopping!

She was a member of the Epicureans, Inc., Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., and she was a charter member of the Commonwealth Chapter of Links, Inc. In addition, she served on the VCU Athletic Board, and the VCU Women for Women Athletics Board. She was a true VCU Rams fan!
