Rosette Pierre-Louis (affectionately known as "Manmi") was born on January 21, 1947 to Rosecianne and Edouard Pierre Louis in Beaumont, Haiti. She fell asleep in death on Thursday, August 24, 2023, surrounded by her loved ones, after a lengthy battle with illness.

Manmi was a fighter, who fought courageously for her health, her faith and her family despite health challenges. Manmi will forever be remembered for her courage, love, hospitality, sense of humor and delicious Haitian cuisine. Early in life, Manmi learned to be selfless.
