

## Roy Joyner

August 3, 1929 - January 9, 2014

ROY JOYNER was born on August 3, 1929 to the late James and Surpannia Joyner. He lost his courageous battle to a lengthy illness and succumbed into a peaceful slumber on January 9, 2014.

In his early years, he attended school in Plymouth, North Carolina. When his family moved to Baltimore, Maryland, he completed his high school education. Prior to going into the U.S. Army, he worked at Chesapeake Rug Company. His time in the Korean War earned him an honorable discharge.

Later, he was joined in Holy Matrimony to Sylvia E. Pipkin on October 9, 1954. This union produced one son and three daughters, Tony, Rita, Teresa and Jennifer. For twenty-eight years he worked as a Baltimore City Fire Fighter, retiring in 1982.

Among his accomplishments were: President of Towarda-Grantley Association, E-Z Travelers Camping Club and Indian Acres Club of Thornburg. At Indian Acres he served in various positions — member of Site Control, Treasurer, Board of Directors and Vice President.

Family and close friends felt his most valued accomplishment was his cooking; especially his sweet potato pies, collard greens, picnic shoulder and punch. Anyone visiting the Joyner house around holidays knew they were in for some good food. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, uncle and friend. He enjoyed a good debate because he was an avid reader and would go get the evidence to prove his point.

He leaves to mourn: his wife of fifty-nine years, Sylvia; four children, Tony

Joyner, Rita Ward (Gregory Sr.), Teresa Bazemore (Edward Eugene) and Jennifer Talioferro (b.k.a. Jen-Jen); one sister, Captoria Smith of Plymouth, NC; eleven grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins; and three very close friends, Crawford, Monte and Alexander (b.k.a. 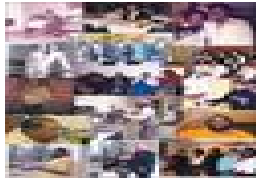
