



Ruby Bunch

June 20, 1932 - September 26, 2016

Mother Ruby (Landrum) Bunch was born June 20, 1932 in Edgefield, South Carolina, to the late Charles and Annie Mae (Oliphant) Landrum. Ruby attended Boston Public and Girls High School. After high school, Ruby later married the late Charles Bunch of Freemont, North Carolina on October 27, 1951 and had six children from this union.

Mother Ruby Bunch attended Refuge Church of Christ in Boston and was saved at the age of 13. She served under her Pastor, Elder Bell for seven years and went on to serve under Apostle T. Hester for fifty-five years. Mother Bunch served long and faithfully as the ABYPU President, President of "See The Need Committee"; she was the Local Missionary President and she served fifteen years as the Diocesan Missionary President for the State of Massachusetts. In addition to the many positions mentioned, she also served on the Usher Board and sang in the youth and adult choir. Not only did she work tirelessly for the church, but she also committed many hours to the Polaroid Corporation where she worked for twenty years until her retirement.

In 1995, the family relocated to Richmond Virginia, where Mother Bunch

joined and

faithfully served at Greater Refuge Church for twenty years under her Pastpr, Apostle Samuel

R. Peters. Mother Bunch was instrumental in organizing the Weeping-Woman Prayer, she

was a member on the Mother's Board, member of the Golden Guild and she was a Noon Day Prayer Warrior. On the international level, she is a lifetime member of the International Women's Council and an Honorary Mother of the International Missionary Department.

Mother Ruby Bunch departed this life on Monday, September 26, 2016, and is preceded in death by her brother and sister-in-law, the late Charles and Adrienne Landrum.
