



## Rudolph Benjamin Walker

May 28, 1935 - September 2, 2016

Rudolph “Rudy” Benjamin Walker was born to the late Benjamin and Pattie S. Walker in Richmond, Virginia on May 28, 1935. He passed away gently to the gates of heaven on September 2, 2016 at the age of 81. He is predeceased by his brothers; Gordon (Aeson) Walker, Sr., Edward Lee Walker, Sr., and Waverly Benjamin Walker; and his twin sister, Caroline M. Walker Banks.
