Russell Alphonso Jones (nicknamed Skeeter) was born June 6, 1953 to Blanche Willis Jones and the late Russell “Frank” Jones. He passed away Tuesday, January 2, 2013. He is preceded in death by his brother, Stanley Jones and a sister Janice Willis.

He accepted Christ at an early age and joined Pilgrim Journey Baptist Church in Richmond.

He graduated from Hermitage High School and shortly after enlisted in the United States Air Forces and received an honorable discharge. He furthered his education at Smithdeal Massey Business College.

Russell was formally employed as a private investigator and also worked for Duron Paint Company. He later established a painting contracting business called “Jones Painting Contractor”.

He left Richmond in 1980 to pursue endeavors in California where he lived

with Uncle Charlie, until he became established. He was married to Maria "Tess" Boromero in 1993.

Russell became a very successful entrepreneur in the Healthcare Staffing business. In 1983, he co-founded Pro-Med Healthcare Staffing and a few years later started his own healthcare staffing business CW Healthcare, named after his grandfather Charlie Willis Jr. He sold his business in 2009 and moved back to Richmond where he retired. Upon retirement, he worked various part time jobs with the last one being Kroger Grocery Store.

With his great motivation and intellect, Russell accomplished most of what he wanted to do in his life. He became a general contractor to build his dream home in Seattle, Washington. Some of his life's enjoyments were golfing, boating, swimming, shooting pool and traveling.
