He knew every Raven statistic and was often the loudest person when watching games. A long running family joke was his sincere desire to be a football player; although he was better suited as a manager or coach! 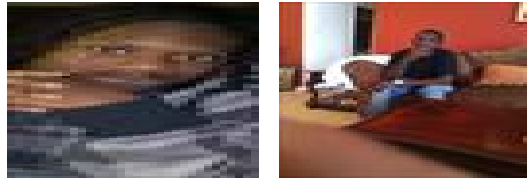
