Russell W. Mosby, age 79 , went to the arms of his Savior on Thursday, December 14, 2006 after a brief illness. Russell was born June 29, 1927 in Baltimore, Md. to the late Dewey H. Mosby and Ruth R. Speed Mosby. He was raised and educated in the New York City School System. He served in the United States Air Force as a paratrooper of the 82nd Airborne Division. After he was honorably discharged from the U.S. Air Force, he worked for the U.S. Postal Service where he later retired in 1970. He had several jobs after his retirement.
