Rustiller A. Tyler, daughter of the late William Thomas Howard Jr. and Marie Andrea Howard, was born on August 21, 1949 in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on October 18, 2018 after courageously fighting a lengthy battle with cancer.

Rustiller was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and graduated from Edmondson High School in 1967. After graduation she worked as a clerical clerk for various businesses including Social Security until she joined Waverly Press in 1977. Rustiller provided Waverly Press with 32 years of dedicated service prior to being laid off in 2009.

Rustiller retired after being laid off, however was determined to work. She worked for the University of Maryland system and various State of Maryland entities until her illness did not allow her.

Affectionately known as “Rusty” or “Stelle” by her family and friends, she loved life. Rusty loved to clean while listening to music. She was a perfectionist and everything had to be in the right place. Stelle was very sociable and loved to have fun; dancing, singing, talking on the phone and visiting with family and friends. Whenever you saw Rusty, she greeted you with a smile. Her appearance was very important to her. Rusty always wore skirts, dresses and heels with her infamous “fishnets.” Rustiller accepted Jesus Christ and was baptized in 2000 at New Antioch Baptist Church under the leadership of Bishop Orlando A. Wilson. She loved her family very much and she always said with her faith and the

love of her family gave her the strength to keep fighting, especially for her grandchildren.

Rusty was married to Theodore Tyler for 19 years and from that union they had 2 children and she gained another mother and father, Elizabeth and Thomas Tyler, 8 sisters and 1 brother (Yvonne, Vivian, Molene, Diane, Gloria, Ethel, Thomasine, Doris and Ralph).

Rustiller was preceded in death by her father and mother, William and Marie Howard. She leaves to cherish her memory: her son Theodore Tyler Jr.; her daughter, Kimberly M. Stills (James W. Stills III); four grandchildren, James W. Stills IV, Kenyen M. Stills, Tyler R. Stills and Brandon Scott; her sister and best friend, Brenda Howard and Melonita Andrews; her godson, Rev.
