RUTH WHITE COLE was born on September 17, 1947 in Lunenburg County, Virginia to the late Robert and Ruth Overby White Jr. She went home to be with the Lord on October 15, 2022, after an extensive battle with cancer,

Ruth resided with her family on a farm in Crew, Virginia and was baptized at an early age. She attended public schools in Lunenburg County and completed two years of college at North Carolina A&T State before moving to Maryland to live with her sister Louise.
