There she received her education at Sparks elementary and Carver High in Towson, Maryland. From a previous marriage, five children were born, one of which preceded her in death (Richard "Ricky" Daughton). Ruth held various jobs. In 1996 she retired from Becton Dickerson in Hunt Valley. After her retirement she did some traveling. Ruth joined church at an early age, but strayed away for a while. Later she met and married her present husband Earle Stephen Wilson on June 1, 1974. In 1975, she reunited with Christ and joined St. James U. A. M. E. Church in Darlington, Maryland where she was a very active member. Ruth was president or vice president of all auxiliaries (somehow she managed to dodge the Trustee Board). Because of her failing health, Ruth and Earle later joined Jordan Memorial U. A. M. E. Church in Baltimore City where she remained until her health continued to fail. Ruth's favorite holiday was Christmas. She loved cooking and being with her family. She loved all her children, but her day was not complete without her grandchildren and great grandchildren.
