Ruth graduated from New Jersey State Teachers College, Glassboro, N.J. in 1937. Her teaching career began in Crisfield, Maryland, where she taught for two years. In 1943, Ruth came to Baltimore and taught at schools # 122, #139, #154, #115 and #204. In 1969, she was assigned to Vice-Principal at #102...serving a total of 36 years in the public school system of Maryland. Upon retirement, she became involved in the tutorial services for the State of Maryland-juvenile division. Also a volunteer reader for the blind. In her youth she was a member of Asburg Methodist Church, Easton, Maryland. Ruth joined Sharp Street United Methodist Church. Two years ago, she was reinstated in Sharp Street Methodist Church. In 1973, Ruth had a stroke, which left her partially paralyzed. All during her illness she maintained a beautiful disposition, always an inspiration to her family and friends. One of her favorite sayings was "just do the best that you can do." She leaves to mourn three sons, one daughter, two sisters and a host of grandchildren, cousins, nephews, nieces, family and friends.
